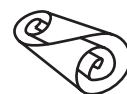


Ribbon Riot



Project Workshop with Cara Gulati

Big ribbons are coming to the party!
Brightly colored fabrics on a black background make your ribbons pop. Machine applique makes the sewing easy and fun.

Supply List

Supplies:

- Ribbon Riot pattern, provided at the workshop
- Freezer paper, about 20-24 feet.
- Water Soluble Glue Stick
- Masking Tape: Natural color ONLY, no colored tape
- Invisible Thread
- Pins
- Pencil, eraser and sharpener
- Paper and fabric scissors
- Iron and pressing surface
- Light box
- Sewing machine with zigzag capabilities + Manual
- Extension table for your machine if you have one
- Open-toed or see-through foot for zigzag
- Empty bobbin
- If you don't prepare your background (see below), bring a rotary cutter, mat, see-through ruler and black thread to piece your background in class. Depending on how fast you work, you may or may not get far enough in the workshop to need it.



Fabric:

These are the fabric requirements to complete the whole quilt top.

1/2 yard each of 6 different colors for the ribbons.

Each ribbon is made with two different fabrics. The more the colors contrast with each other in each ribbon shape, the better your ribbons will look. If you are unsure, bring more to select from and we can make your choices in the workshop together!

2 3/4 yards black for the background.

THIS IS NOT REQUIRED BEFORE CLASS, but you can do it if you want to. Cut two pieces of the black fabric to 48" x 35". Sew together the 48" sides to make a 69.5" x 48" background.
