Twieling Twister Reoject Workshop with Cara Gulati Ribbons twirl and float in this fun quilt design! These ribbons are made using gradations in this project workshop. Machine applique makes sewing these ribbons fun and easy. Partial seam piecing is a sneaky piecing method to add modern floating rectangles and squares. **Supply List** Supplies: Freezer paper Water Soluble Glue Stick Masking Tape Invisible Thread Black thread Pins Pencil Paper and fabric scissors Rotary cutter and mat See-through ruler Iron and pressing surface Light box Sewing machine with zigzag capabilities Open-toed or see-through foot for zigzag. Empty bobbin Twirling Twister pattern, provided at the workshop. <u>Fabric:</u> These are the fabric requirements to complete the whole 60" square quilt top.

- 1/8 yard each: Light Red/Pink, Light Turquoise, Light Green and Light Orange
 - 1/8 yard each: Medium Red/Pink, Medium Turquoise, Medium Green and Medium Orange
 - 1/4 yard each: Dark of Red/Pink, Dark Turquoise, Dark Green and Dark Orange
 - 1/8 yard of grey for the center squares of the ribbon blocks
 - 1/2 yard each of 5 different colors for the solid rectangles and center square of the quilt top
 - 2 yards black for the backgrounds and border
 - $^{1\!\!/_{\! 2}}$ yard for a contrasting binding
